I am very pleased to have joined the Faculty here in Sydney. After 13 years teaching at the University of Hong Kong, I took up my appointment as Dean of the Faculty of Architecture in early January and went straight in to Information Day where I met prospective members of our family. From the briefings I have received and my conversations with a wide range of alumni, staff and friends of the Faculty, it is clear to me that there are many challenges ahead. The tremendous changes in the world are affecting tertiary education and the professions in which our graduates engage. I am excited by the potential and opportunities and look forward to meeting you to explore and realise these futures. The most fundamental shift in tertiary education is the substantial shift to a research agenda. Research underlies our teaching and is embedded in the learning experience for all students. I am happy to meet with you if you wish to discuss the future of the Faculty and our University agenda.
